14 Muharram 1426H / 23 February 2005M Brunei Darussalam's 21st National Day:

His Majesty stresses on the importance of strengthening religious education system at elementary level; while religious education system should produce 'ulama (Muslim scholars) and intellectuals at higher level.

02 Sya'ban 1426H / 06 September 2005M 17th Convocation of UBD:

His Majesty states that the second university which he has suggested previously must be an Islamic university, since the country has a strong base for this, and which should fulfill the nation's needs.

11 Sya'ban 1427H / 04 September 2006M 18th Convocation of UBD:


His Majesty emphasises that the second university will be a pure Islamic higher educational institution to be our landmark in the world and in the hereafter.



On 11 Zulhijjah 1427H / 01 January 2007M Universiti Islam Sultan Sharif Ali (UNISSA) was established by the consent and announcement made by His Majesty Kebawah Duli Yang Maha Mulia Paduka Seri Baginda Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah Muʻizzaddin Waddaulah ibni al-Marhum Sultan Haji Omar 'Ali Saifuddien Saʻadul Khairi Waddin, Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Negara Brunei Darussalam.

UNISSA was named after the third Sultan of Brunei, Sultan Sharif Ali who reigned from 1425M - 1432M. Sultan Sharif Ali was a very pious ruler and was therefore nicknamed "Sultan Berkat" (Blessed Sultan). Sultan Sharif Ali was the direct descendant of the Prophet Sallallahu 'Alaihi Wasallam through his grandson Sayyidina Hassan Radiallahu 'anhu. Sultan Sharif Ali was the first ruler to build a mosque and fortified the defense of Brunei by ordering his people to build a stone fortress. He governed Brunei according to Islamic principles and his reign was popular and highly respected.





QUALITY EDUCATION

UNISSA offers well-designed tertiary programmes undergraduate at and postgraduate levels as part of comprehensive educational system to produce 'ulama (Muslim scholars) and other human resources who are highspirited, well-balanced, professional. knowledgeable, respectful, and pious.

STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMME

Bachelor degree students who have obtained CGPA 3.50 and above throughout the first two (2) years of study are given an opportunity to study abroad for a year (2 semesters) at any of UNISSA's partner universities in the Middle East, United Kingdom, or Malaysia.

This programme aims to give students a great opportunity to experience studying abroad under different education systems, ways of life, and cultures. Apart from that, it also aims to nurture the students into becoming global citizens while sustaining the values of a good Muslim.



ACADEMIC EXERCISE



An Academic Exercise course is offered in the final year of study. It is an opportunity for bachelor degree students to conduct research under the supervision of a faculty academic staff in their respective fields of study.

Apart from engaging these students in the processes of intellectual inquiry, problem solving, and creative thinking, the course aims to enhance intellectual exchange and collaboration between undergraduates, faculty, and the organisation where they do their industrial training.

INDUSTRIAL TRAINING


Industrial Training course is conducted in the third year of study to provide undergraduate students with work experience of day-to-day operations at selected organisations so that they understand the practical-work processes and gain valuable insights into the aspirations, needs, and views of the organisation they are attached to.

The duration of the attachment is nine (9) weeks and usually commences after Second Semester Final Examination period. However, for Bachelor of Science in Islamic Finance and Bachelor of Business Management programmes, the duration of the attachment is 22 weeks.



Although co-curriculum is a non-academic course, it is a formal part of education in UNISSA where it is one of the University Required Courses offered for bachelor degree students. The course is graded and is included in the students' overall CGPA. There are currently four (4) areas in the co-curriculum course; spiritual activities, clubs (including uniformed groups), physical sport activities, and community service.

The co-curriculum course aims to encourage the students' holistic development in terms of life skills, competencies, and values. Participation in various activities also helps foster social integration and deepens the students' sense of belonging, commitment, and sense of responsibility to the university, community, and country as a whole.

FACULTY OF USULUDDIN

The Faculty of Usuluddin aims to produce 'ulama (scholars) who promote righteous values gained from knowledge and have expertise in the area of Tafsir, Hadith, Aqidah and Da'wah.



VISION

To become a distinguished centre of knowledge, belief system and faith, based on The Holy Qur'an, the Prophetic traditions and the principles of *Ahlu al-Sunnah wa al-Jama'ah*.

MISSION

To introduce authentic academic programmes and produce highly qualified graduates from a variety of disciplines to serve Islam and the Muslim community in Brunei Darussalam and the Muslim world.

OBJECTIVES

- To protect the purity of Islamic doctrines and to defend any deviational and inclinations trends.
- To produce Muslim intellectuals and specialists in the disciplines of Usuluddin and its sciences.
- To maximise the study of classical and contemporary Islamic sources in textual form or media in order to defend any destructives or criticisms from the non-Muslims/orientalists.
- Striving to increase the number of scholars combining knowledge ('ilm) with action ('amal) and faith (al-'aqidah) with practice (suluk) in Brunei society in particular and Islamic societies in general.
- To produce Muslim preachers that have strong foundations of the al-Qur'an and Sunnah of Prophet Muhammad Sallallahu 'Alaihi Wasallam.

BACHELOR OF USULUDDIN (TAFSIR AND HADITH)

This four (4) year programme is designed to produce competent graduates who are well versed in the discipline of Tafsir and Hadith. This programme includes the following courses:

- i. Science of al-Hadith ('Ulum al-Hadith),
- ii. Methodology of Exegetes (Manahij al-Mufassirin),
- iii. Science of Impugnment and Validation ('Ilm al-Jarh wa al-Ta'dil),
- iv. Principles of Takhrij and its Rules (Usul al-Takhrij wa Qawa'iduhu),
- V. Methodology of Narrators of Hadith (Manahij al-Muhaddithin), and
- vi. Thematic Exegesis (al-Tafsir al-Maudu'i).

BACHELOR OF USULUDDIN ('AQIDAH AND DA'WAH)

This four (4) year programme is designed to produce competent graduates who are well versed in the discipline of 'Aqidah and Da'wah. This programme includes the following courses:

- i. Introduction to Da'wah (al-Madkhal ila al-Da'wah),
- ii. The Islamic Sects (al-Firaq al-Islamiyyah),
- iii. The Islamic World Today (Hadir al-'Alam al-Islami),
- iv. Islamic Philosophy (al-Falsafah al-Islamiyyah),
- v. Contemporary Ideological Trends (Tayarat Fikriyyah Mu'asirah), and
- vi. Oratory (Fann al-Khatabah).

Notes:

Students from both programmes are required to participate in Industrial Training course arranged by the Faculty in their third year of study. The training usually commences after Second Semester Final Examination period.

Third year students are also required to conduct a research project (Bahth al-Takharruj) in their selected area of study and submit a written report, in Arabic, in the second semester of their final year.

MASTER OF USULUDDIN (COURSEWORK AND DISSERTATION)

This two (2) year programme aims to enhance and strengthen students' knowledge in Islamic studies particularly in the major area of Usuluddin, namely The Holy Qur'an, the sunnah, Islamic da'wah, and comparative religions.

A total of six (6) courses are offered which include three (3) mandatory courses:

- Studies in Books of Religion (Dirasaat fi Kutub al-Adyan),
- ii. Miraculous Knowledge in the Qur'an (al-I'jaz al-'Ilmy fi al-Qur'an al-Karim), and Studies in the Hadith Books (Dirasaat fi Kutub al-Sunnah).

These courses are offered in the first year of study and students are required to pass the mandatory courses before they are allowed to continue with their studies in the second year.

Upon completion of the coursework, they are required to write a dissertation, in Arabic, on an approved topic under the supervision of an academic staff member appointed by the Faculty. The master degree will only be conferred after the student has successfully fulfilled all the requirements as prescribed in the Postgraduate Regulations of UNISSA.

MASTER OF USULUDDIN (RESEARCH)

The Faculty also offers a master degree programme by research. This programme is only offered to applicants who are exceptionally qualified to undertake research in Arabic, English, and Malay languages. Applicants are required to submit their research proposal to be assessed by the Postgraduate Studies Committee.

In line with the University's aim to produce qualified and competitive Muslim scholars, the Faculty welcomes qualified applicants to apply to this programme in any selected area of studies. Applicants are expected to have a good background in research methodology and also fluent in the language selected for their research. As part of the evaluation process, candidates may be required to sit and pass a special examination as prescribed by Postgraduate Regulations as well as to engage with particular units of study or prescribed readings at the Faculty's discretion.



DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN USULUDDIN (RESEARCH)

The Faculty offers a doctoral programme in the area of Usuluddin. This programme aims to encourage qualified candidates in the field of Usuluddin to conduct research projects in their area of interest. Applicants are required to submit their research proposal to be assessed by the Faculty before any final decision can be made by the Postgraduate Studies Committee.

Applicants are expected to have a good background in research methodology and fluent in the language selected for their research. As part of the evaluation process, they may be required to sit and pass a special examination together with oral examination to be conducted by the Faculty and fulfil necessary requirements as prescribed by Postgraduate Regulations of UNISSA. Successful applicants will be supervised by academic staff member appointed by the Faculty.
