**QUESTION 1** (10 marks)

**QUESTION 1** (15 marks)

Someone wrote: "It is reported that many Companions of the Prophet (may Allah be pleased with them) as well as second-generation Muslim scholars used to listen to singing and did not see anything wrong with it."

- (a) Analyze the methodological flaw of this statement;
- (b) Discuss the views of scholars on singing and music.

Cosmetic surgeries are usually different from reconstructive surgeries.

(a) Elaborate on those differences;

(b) What is the implication of those differences relating to the hukm shar i.

#### **QUESTION 3**

(15 marks)

- 1. Ibn 'Umar (May Allah be pleased with them) said: The Messenger of Allah (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) said: "Those who draw pictures will be punished on the Day of Resurrection; and it will be said to them: 'Breathe soul into what you have created." [Al-Bukhari and Muslim].
- 2. 'Aishah (May Allah be pleased with her) said: The Messenger of Allah (sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) visited me after returning from a journey, and I had a shelf with a thin cloth curtain hanging over it and on which there were portraits. When he saw it, the colour of his face changed (because of anger) and he said: "O 'Aishah! the most grievous torment from Allah on the Day of Resurrection will be for those who imitate (Allah) in the act of His creation." 'Aishah said: We tore it into pieces and made a cushion or two cushions out of that.[Al-Bukhari and Muslim].
  - Based on these two *hadiths*, discuss the rules relating to prohibition and permissibility of drawing and sculpturing.
