The delegation was led by PPPBD chief commissioner, Hajah Siti Hafsa binti Haji Abdul Halim as and training commissioner, Noraini binti Ibrahim.

The other members are Aida binti Abdul Rahman, Honorable Secretary of the PPPBD, Kaniz binti Abdul Shakoor, International and Activities Secretary, Hajah Ostinah binti Abdul Othman, Commissioner of the Girl Guide Rangers and Nasriah binti Awang Nasib, Commissioner of Communications.

The workshop is scheduled to take place in the Baguio city from December 7-13.

It is planned to support both volunteers

and professionals to understand the new policies on Educational Programme and Adult Training, Learning and Development thoroughly.

It will include the process of Educational Programme framework development.

It will also provide an opportunity to understand how a well-developed adult training, learning and development framework can equip adults to perform their roles more effectively.

At the end of the workshop, the participants are expected to develop a draft action plan to strengthen the Girl Guide/Girl Scout experience and utilise it to enhance their member organisations.

The workshop aims to boost the confidence of the participants to apply their learning in their own national contexts. The PPPBD is a member of the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS).
