- (a) Analyze the methodological flaw of this statement.
- (b) Discuss the view of Muslim scholars on singing and music.

QUESTION 2 (15 marks)

Due to an accident, Siti got a big cut on her face. Even after doing a careful a big scar was left on her face. She was advised to undergo a cosmetic surgery to remove the scar or at least reduce it. Since Siti was not happy with the shape of her nose. She decided to undergo a double surgery on both the scar and the nose to save costs.

Discuss the permissibility of such surgery under Islamic law. Support your answer with the opinion of Muslim scholars.

QUESTION 3 (15 marks)

Ibn 'Umar (May Allah be pleased with them) said: The Messenger of Allah (Sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) said: "Those who draw pictures will be punished on the Day of Resurrection; and it will be said to them: 'Breathe soul into what you have created."

'Aishah (May Allah be pleased with her) said: The Messenger of Allah (Sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) visited me after returning from a journey, and I had a shelf with a thin cloth curtain hanging over it and on which there were portraits. When he saw it, the colour of his face changed (because of anger) and he said: "O 'Aishah! the most grievous torment from Allah on the Day of Resurrection will be for those who imitate (Allah) in the act of His creation." 'Aishah said: We tore it into pieces and made a cushion or two cushions out of that.
