- 7) What is the opposite of The Greater Connecting *Medd*.
- 8) Explain the letters of the Soft *Medd*.
- 9) What is the length of elongation for the Lengthening with a Presented Sukoon rule?
- 10) What is the meaning of the Arabic term مد البدل ?
