 - ج The Permissible Stop
 - ق Better not to Stop
 - وقفه The Longer Pause
 - ق Better not to Stop

Answer the following questions:

- a. What is the meaning of the Mushaf Medinah?
- b. Define the meaning of al-Isti'ādzah. Explain briefly the virtues of al-Isti'ādzah. Describe how al-Isti'adzah can be recited everytime you want to start reciting the Qur'an.
- c. Explain the arguments that the scholars have regarding the Basmalah in Surah al-Fatihah.
- d. Describe the ways of how you can begin reciting a surah with the Basmalah and the Isti'adzah.

Answer the following questions:

- a- What is the difference between *Tartīl* and *Tajwīd*?
- b- Define the meaning of Islamic Calligraphy.
- c- If someone returns and recites back the Quran after cutting off, should he start with *al-Isti'ādzah* and basmalah? Why?
- d- *Jam` al-Qur'an* in the classical literature has various meanings. Discuss!

QUESTION 4 (4 MARKS)

- a- How many years of the revelation in the a-Qur'an took place and mention the places. Name FOUR surah in the Qur'an where you can find the Prostrations of *Tilāwah*.
- b- What is the du'a for Prostrations of *Tilāwah*?
- c- Explain types of al-Lahn.
- d- As far as the written text is concerned, one may distinguish three stages. Elaborate!

QUESTION 5 (6 MARKS)

- a- Explain briefly the internal manners when reading the Qur'an.
- b- Explain the different levels of reading the Qur'an.
- c- Define the meaning of *ibtidā* (beginning) and its rules. Meaning of *al-Waṣl* (join verses) and its rules.
- d- Elaborate eight (8) characteristics of Al-Qur'an al-Karim/Islam.
