Question 1 [10 Marks]

The prohibition of showing aurah is an order from Allah SWT which has been mentioned many times in the Quran and Hadith.

The obligation to cover aurah is written in Quran Surah Al A'raf : 26

يٰۤاٰدَمُ قَدْ اَنْزَلْنَا عَلَيْكَ لِبَاسًا يُّورِي سَوْءَاتِكُمْ وَرِيشًا وَلِبَاسٌ طَيِّبٌ ذٰلِكَ خَيْرٌ ذٰلِكَ
مِّنْ اٰيٰتِ اللّٰهِ لَعَلَّهُمْ يَذَّكَّرُوْنَ

“O children of Adam, We have bestowed upon you clothing to conceal your private parts and as adornment. But the clothing of righteousness – that is best. That is from the signs of Allah that perhaps they will remember”.

Explain the wisdom and benefits of covering the awrah based on this verse.

Question 2 [10 Marks]

The wearing of silk dress and gold are merely forbidden for men and not women. The ban is not without reason, human or divine in nature, but it is always a reasonable one that greatly entails the “why” aspect of the prohibition.

- i. Explain the wisdom behind the prohibition of silk and gold for men. (8 marks)
- ii. Provide the hadith regarding this prohibition. (2 marks)

Question 3 [10 Marks]

Prohibition of alcohol and drugs is really emphasized in Islam as it one of the fundamentals for the Muslims faith and attitude.

- i. Everything that is intoxicating is forbidden by Allah Almighty. State any verse of Al Qur'an regarding this? (2 marks)
- ii. Explain what you understand and the wisdom of the prohibition in the verse in (i). (8 marks)

Question 4 [10 Marks]

Below is the Qur'anic verses that emphasizes on the prohibition of the blood. Discuss.

قُلْ لَا أَجِدُ فِي مَا أُوحِيَ إِلَيَّ مُحَرَّمًا عَلَى طَاعِمٍ يَطْعَمُهُ إِلَّا أَنْ يَكُونَ مَيْتَةً أَوْ
دَمًا مَسْفُوحًا أَوْ لَحْمَ خِنْزِيرٍ فَإِنَّهُ رِجْسٌ أَوْ فِسْقًا أُهِلَّ لِغَيْرِ اللَّهِ بِهِ فَمَنْ
أَضْطَرَّ غَيْرَ بَاغٍ وَلَا عَادٍ فَإِنَّ رَبَّكَ غَفُورٌ رَحِيمٌ ﴿١٤٥﴾
