Related by Ahmad, Abû Dawûd, Ibn Mâjah, and Al-Hâkim regarded it as Sahîh.

c) Who is the narrator of this hadith? Introduce him. (1 mark)

d) Who are the recipients of the zakat? Discuss! (6 marks)

e) Explain the recipients of Zakat in Brunei Darussalam as there regulated by the law. (4 marks)

- e) Discuss the types of divorce based on Ibn Umar hadith? (4 marks)
- f) Explain the essential requirements (rukun) of divorce. (3 marks)

- c) Define *riba*! And explain the phases of its prohibition in Islamic history by giving its authority from the Holy Quran. (4.5 marks)
- d) What are the objects on which the prohibition of riba is applied? (3 marks)
- e) What are the types of riba? (2 marks)
- f) Is banking interest considered as of riba? (2 marks)
